The 9th Annual Northeast Postal History and Ephemera Show is still scheduled for Saturday & Sunday, July 18 & 19, 2020 at the Polish Community Center in Albany, NY. You will receive further updates on this show as they become available.

Originally, this newsletter was to be mailed to help advertise the Fort Orange Stamp Club Show scheduled for April 19, 2020.
